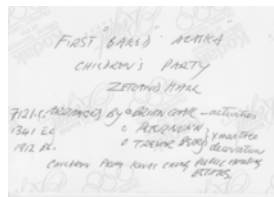




### The First Baked Alaska Zetland Hall

The performances were also undertaken by the Kwai Chung children themselves.

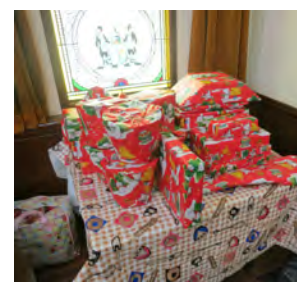
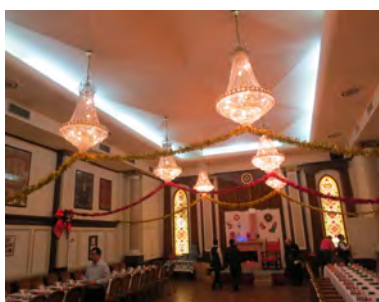
